

These texts will be used to explore our topic on aviation.

Maths

This term we will focus on:

Number - Ratio - Children will understand that a ratio shows the relationship between two values and can describe how one is related to another.

Statistics - Children will build on their experience of interpreting data in context from Year 5, using their knowledge of scales to read information accurately

Geometry - Children recap how to line up the protractor accurately, and identify which side of the scale to read. They link this to their understanding of angle sizes.

Children read the measurement and practise measuring angles given in different orientations.

Writina

We will be using two books as our main texts this term: Sky Chasers and Brightstorm. Both books are high-flying adventures that explore the rich history and vocabulary of the discovery of and the subsequent adventures of the secrets of flight.

These texts have been chosen because they provide a number of writing opportunities for our children to write at a mastery Year 6 level.

Reading

We will be using a 'The Lion above the Door' by Onjali Rauf as part of a transition unit to prepare children for secondary school. This will be ongoing with links to writing and PSHE lessons. Each child will have their own copy of the book to take to their new school.
