Developing our school - new building at the front of school

Dear Parents & Carers

Our school serves more than 450 children every day and we work hard to invest in our grounds each year. It is a never ending cycle of improvement that the school staff and governors are committed to.

Building a good school

The front entrance to the school will be changing in 2019. An extension will be built to increase the school meeting space. The new room will help staff have a professional area they need to meet with parents and each other.

The extension will also have external doors so that we can use it for coffee mornings and community events when required.

Planning permission has been granted and a temporary barrier will be installed to ensure parents can still easily access the main entrance during the works.



Once the building has been completed a new parent shelter is also planned for the area. The work should be complete by April 2019.

In the immediate future I know this is a cold and wet time of year and I understand that parents often wait at the front of school for clubs to finish. Feedback from the parent forum has raised the issue that a few parents do miss the shelter that has been moved in preparation for the new building.



I would invite any parent to use the main entrance waiting area to keep warm and dry in December and January. We will be opening the adjoining meeting room next to the office to allow the extra space to ensure mums and dads can have a better area for waiting from now on. Do come in and stay warm and dry if you are early for collecting your child.

I appreciate that these changes do impact on our families but that the long benefits will be worth it.
