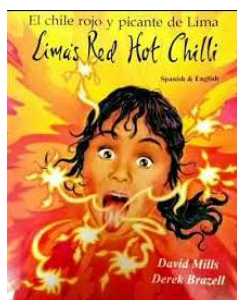

Topic Overview & Key Text



Lima's Red Hot Chilli by David Mills and Derek Brazell

A humorous award-winning illustrated book about a hungry little girl. Lima is one hungry little girl. She comes upon a shiny, delicious red hot chilli. She takes a big bite into the chilli, and experiences a spectacular firework display in her mouth!

Food and Celebrations

We will talk about what foods are special to us, make links to our own experiences and how it makes us feel. We will read other texts to discover new and exciting foods. We will share our experiences of different celebrations in our great city of Manchester. We will look at celebration foods from different cultures.

We will learn about the Christmas story, learn new songs. We will learn about why Christmas is special for Christians and look at similarities to other festivals like Diwali and Eid.



Maths

We are learning to count beyond ten. We will always make sure that we say numbers in the right order.

We are also making sure that we say one number each time we count as well as saying how many we have counted in a full sentence.

Writing

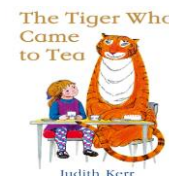
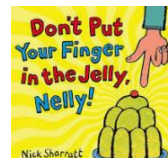
We will be learning about and drawing pictures of different foods then writing labels and lists. We will use our growing phonic knowledge to read and spell simple words. The children will be writing a list of foods linked to the story and their learning experiences.

Early Reading

The children will be practising their RWI Set 1 sounds and using their phonic knowledge to read and spell simple words. They will begin to take home phonetically decodable books.
