April's attendance was **92.36%**.

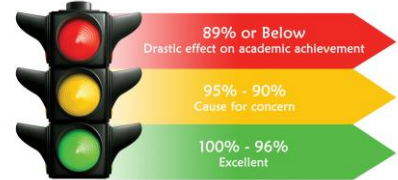
**Our aim is 96%.**
